Here's what I was doing that didn't work:

```
set cmd.ActiveConnection = cn
ssql = "SELECT EMEENAMM from EMPLOYEE where EMEENAMM>'letter'"
cmd.CommandText = ssql
set parmTemp = cmd.CreateParameter("letter", adChar, adParmInput, 1)
cmd.Parameters.Append parmTemp
cmd("letter") = "d"
set rs = cmd.Execute(lrecs, , adCmdText)
```

Using a stored procedure in access worked fine this way. It's just the SQL syntax I don't know.

Any examples along these lines would be greatly appreciated.
